The Board Study Session was called to order at 6:00 PM by Paul Golob, in the Granger High School Multi-Purpose Room, followed by the flag salute.

COMMUNICATION TO THE BOARD:

A. SAFETY PLAN UPDATE-CHRIS WEEDIN SSOCC & SAFETY LEADS

Christ Weedon from ESD 105 shared our district's end of year safety report. He reviewed some of the safety issues that the district worked through during the year. Chris wanted to let the board know that Granger School District has a healthy crisis planning team, and highlighted the central office for their planning, and pointed out this is not often seen in other districts. Chris also gave an overview of the upcoming August 16th Run, Barricade, Fight training that ESD will provide to all new staff in our district. The upcoming 19-20 school year will move Granger School District up to Fortress Stage 2. This stage will begin incorporating a transportation safety plan, which will begin soon. Safety leads from the buildings discussed safety topics that they believed were working well. The Inpoint text system has been very beneficial for safety communication.

B. GSD DRESS CODE

A group of students from the GMS leadership class presented results from a student survey. They also shared a letter collected from GMS students regarding the current dress code and the desire to change it. Board members shared the background and interest regarding the dress code and how it came to be adopted. There were a lot of parent concerns that brought on the change. The board thanked students for their work on the topic.

C. GHS & GMS STUDENT HANDBOOKS

Principal Mike Carlson and vice Principal Isidro Caballero shared updates to their student handbooks. Some topics updated were discipline changes to align with new state laws and cell phone usage.

D. SCIENCE CURRICULUM ADOPTION RECOMMENDATION-PAT ULERY

Federal Program Director Pat Ulery shared the curriculum adoption process which included visiting other districts and reviewing potential curriculum. Each building's curriculum representative shared

their recommendation to the board. Sarah Gardiner, Special Ed. Director also shared the curriculum recommended for the special education department.

E. ASB UPDATE-JOSH GOLOB

Josh Golob updated the board on the high schools ASB department. The ASB had great success with their last blood drive which collected 39 units of blood. The high school recently hosted a college signing day assembly and it was a great success.
